

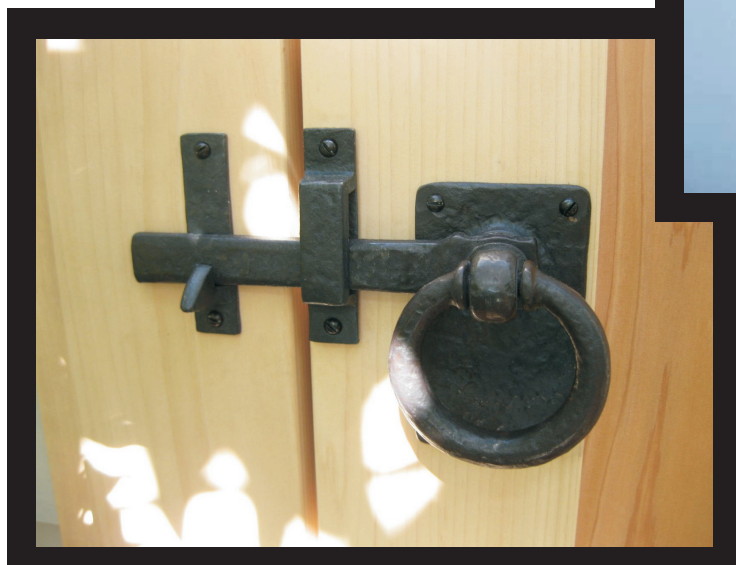
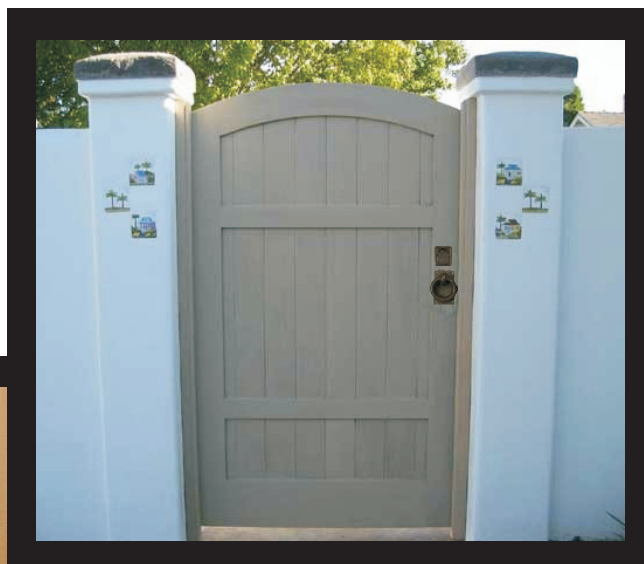
## Ring Latches

A ring latch is a two-sided gate latch, operable from both sides of the gate. On the street-side of the gate, you'll see a backplate with a ring on it. The yard-side will have a backplate also with a ring on it, but the ring will be attached to a latch-arm.

Turning the ring from either side of the gate lifts the arm out of the catch so the gate can open.

Ring latches can be either gravity-assisted or spring-loaded, depending on the manufacturer.

Ring latches can be installed on both in-swinging and out-swinging gates. On out-swinging gates, however, the latch-arm side of the gate latch will be on the street-side of the gate.



A dark bronze ring latch. This gate latch is self-latching and spring-loaded.

A cast-iron ring antique ring latch. Also available in cast-aluminum for better corrosion resistance. These latches are self-latching, gravity-assisted.
